	<b>Charter School Laws</b>	<p>There are four types of charter schools in state policy: Home-rule district charters. Open enrollment charters. Campus or campus program charters. University or college charters. Open enrollment charter schools have an initial charter term of 5 years and renewals are for 10-year terms. Texas also allows low-performing public schools to contract with high-performing charter school operators for the shared operation of the school or to provide educational services or programs within the public school as an alternative to intervention.</p>	<p><a href="#">TX.
